**Project Details**

**Site:** Sidney Ave – Well 8

**Description:** The old motor & pump failed and need to be replaced.

**Scope of Work:**

- Remove existing well pump and motor
- Install new well pump and motor in well 8 with the following specs:
  1. 1 New pump at 350-390 gpm @ 380' of TDH.
  2. 1 New motor at 50 HP, 360V, 3ph
  3. New power cable
  4. 1 well sounding tube – 1"x300'
  5. 1 well level sensor tube – 1"x300'
  6. 3 6" in-line check valves
- Start up, testing, and troubleshooting shall be included

This project consists of work to be performed within 45 calendar days from contract date and consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor and other work or items incidental theretofore.

The following applies to the proposal:

1. Per RCW39.12.030, this is a prevailing wage contract and workers shall receive the prevailing wage rate as established by Labor and Industries (L&I). A copy of the current wage rates is attached, per RCW39.12.020.
2. A Payment and Performance Bond at 100% of the Contract Value and a two-year Maintenance Bond at 20% of the Contract Value.
3. The company will submit the L&I approved Intent to Pay ***with*** the invoice. If there is more than one invoice, submit the Intent to Pay ***with*** the first invoice and submit the Affidavit ***with*** the last invoice. **We will not accept the invoice without the approved Intent to Pay from L&I.**

4. The successful bidder must have a City business license prior to award of contract and must be an active participant on the MRSC Small Works Roster for the City of Port Orchard. 5. The company is required to have the following liability insurance and list the City of Port Orchard as a "Named Insured" on the company's policy.
  - a. \$1,000,000 Property Damage
  - b. \$1,000,000 Bodily Injury
