

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

CITY OF PORT ORCHARD WELL 13 – DRILLING PROJECT CONTRACT NO. C077-18

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Clerk for the City of Port Orchard, 216 Prospect Street, Port Orchard, WA 98366 until 12:00 PM on November 28, 2018, for construction of the Well 13 – Drilling Project, Contract No. C077-18. No proposals will be accepted after the above-stated time. At 12:30 PM following the above-stated date, the proposals will be publicly opened and read.

The project consists of work to be performed within 200 working days from the date of Notice to Proceed, and consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and other work or items incidental theretofore and as generally described as follows:

Schedule A

- 1) The drilling of an 8-inch test/pilot hole to 1,500 feet below ground surface (bgs) using mud-rotary methods (Schedule A)

Schedule B

(to be accomplished if a suitable aquifer is found in Schedule A work)

- 2) Install 30-inch casing to 150 feet bgs and expansion of the pilot hole below 150 feet to 30-inch nominal diameter to accommodate the placement and sealing of a 20-inch casing (no less than 26-inch hole)
- 3) Install and seal 20-inch permanent casing from an estimated depth of 1,300 feet to land surface using mud rotary drilling methods
- 4) Drilling of a 20-inch nominal hole from an estimated depth of 1,300 feet to an estimated depth of 1,500 feet (minimum 18-inch) using reverse-circulation fluid-rotary methods and employing clean water as the drilling fluid
- 5) Completion of a deep production well by placing as much as 200 feet of stainless steel well screen in the reverse-circulation hole
- 6) Development of the screened section
- 7) Testing of completed and developed well by step drawdown and constant rate 24-hour pump tests.

(The list does not include all the incidental work for each category, but is merely provided to give an overview of the Well 13 – Drilling Project.)

The Engineer's construction estimate for this project is \$1,100,000 to 1,400,000.

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Access to bidding information (plans, specifications, addenda, and Bidders List) is available through City of Port Orchard's on-line plan room. Free-of-charge access is provided to Prime Bidders, Subcontractors, and Vendors by going to www.bxwa.com and clicking on "Posted Projects," "Public Works," and "City of Port Orchard." This on-line plan room provides Bidders with fully usable online documents with the ability to: download, view, print, order full/partial plan sets from numerous reprographic sources, and a free online digitizer/take-off tool. It is recommended that Bidders "Register" in order to receive automatic e-mail notification of future addenda and to place themselves on the "Self-Registered Bidders List." Bidders that do not register will not be automatically notified of addenda and will need to periodically check the on-line plan room for addenda issued on this project. All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid security (bid deposit) in the form of a cash deposit, certified or cashier's check, postal money order, or surety bond made payable to the City of Port Orchard, for a sum not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid, including sales tax. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory payment and performance bonds within the time stated in the Specifications, the bid security (bid deposit/bond) shall be forfeited to the City of Port Orchard.

This project is fully funded through the Washington State Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) program with federal funds from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). DWSRF requirements and provisions must be met by general contractors and all subcontractors. The City of Port Orchard is an Equal Opportunity and Affirmative Action Employer. Small, Minority- and Women-owned firms are encouraged to submit bids. All work performed on this project will be subject to the higher of the prevailing state or federal wage rates. The American Iron and Steel provision applies to this project.

The award of the Contract will go to the qualified bidder submitting the lowest responsible bid. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids or waive any informality in the bidding and make the award as deemed to be in the best interest of the City.

The bidder should be aware that a separate project, Well 13 - Site Preparation, will need to be completed on site before access to the site is available for well drilling activities. It is estimated that the Site Preparation Project will be completed by the end of March 2019. The successful bidder will be notified by the City the date of Notice to Proceed within 60 calendar days of the Notice of Award. The prices in the successful bidder's Schedule of Contract Prices shall remain valid at all times after the bid opening. Revisions to the prices will not be allowed unless written permission is provided by the City.

The City of Port Orchard in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, nondiscrimination in federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award.

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Notice is given to all potential bidders that any bid responses may be subject to release under the Public Records Act Chapter 42.56 RCW and the City may be required to disclose bid responses upon a request. Bidders are advised to mark any records believed to be trade secrets or confidential in nature as “confidential.” If records marked as “confidential” are found to be responsive to the request for records, the City may elect to give notice to the bidder of the request so as to allow the bidder to seek a protective order from a Court. Please be advised, however, that any records deemed responsive to a public records request may be released at the sole discretion of, and without notice by, the City.
