Commemorative Brick and Tile Information



Commemorative TILE \$100 : A “6x6” quarry tile placed outside the main entrance to City Hall on Prospect Street. Tiles will display a three line message of no more than 15 characters or spaces each.

Commemorative BRICK \$75: A “3.5”x7” brick will be placed outside the Police Department entrance to City Hall on Bay Street. Bricks will display a two-line message of no more than 18 characters or spaces each.

If you would like to add a symbol or emblem to your Commemorative Brick or Tile, please see the attached sheet for more information. Each symbol or emblem is an additional \$10.00.

You may use the following characters on your Commemorative Brick or Tile at no additional charge: ! @ # \$ % ^ & * () _ - + =

This is a highly weather dependent process. It must be dry (no surface moisture) and outside temperatures must be above 60F. Bricks are especially porous and require no rain or ground moisture in the previous 5 days. Due to these weather constraints and our NW weather patterns, field inscriptions are usually only conducted May 1 through September 30.

DIRECTORY OF SYMBOLS

The symbols and emblems on the following pages are already programmed in our computers. We realize that we're only scratching the surface on generic symbols, and would welcome any simple symbols or school emblems that we might add to our program. Most symbols are engraved 1" high, but this may vary depending on the specified letter height and material. The symbols here are not shown at the actual size.

CODE NUMBERS

Each symbol has been assigned an individual code number. These code numbers are not random -each digit represents an important element. We are providing a key for you so that you may utilise the numbers also.

To most easily explain the coding, we will use this example which you can see on the facing page:

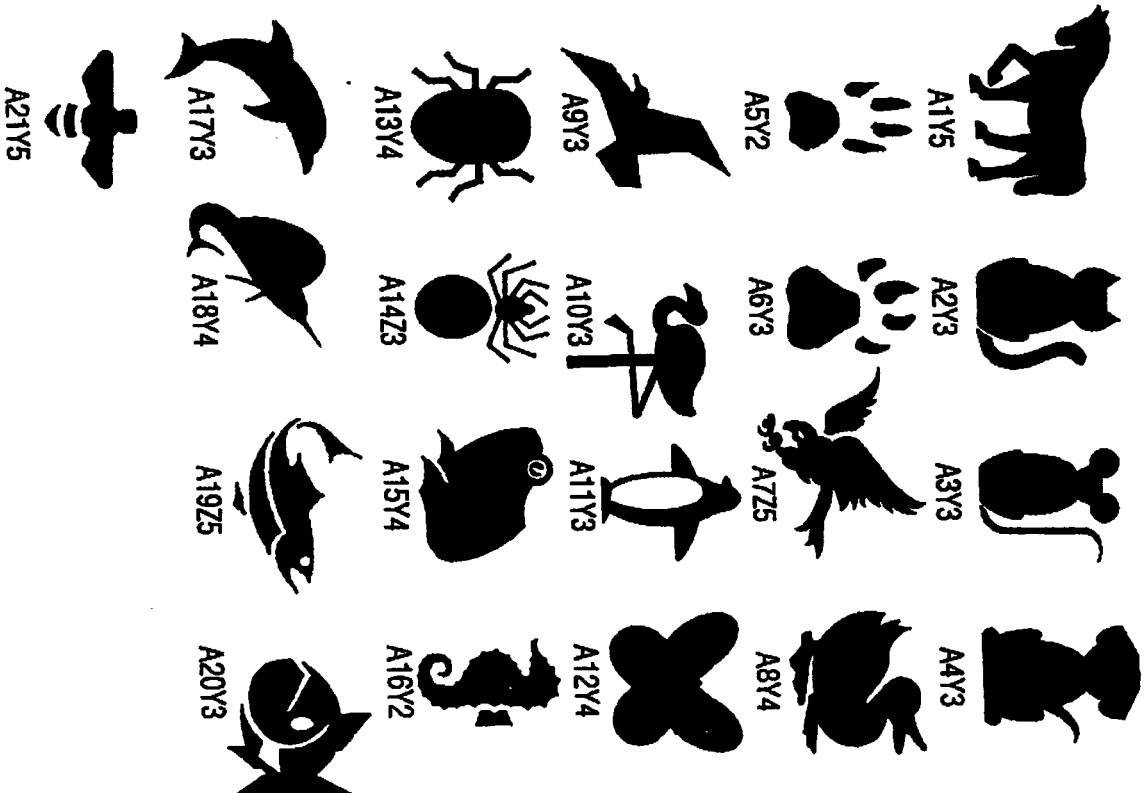
#	Line 1	Line 2	Special Instructions
25	A4Y3 FIDO	THE TOP DOG	A4Y3 on Line 1

- 1) The first letter (A) represents the category where the symbol is located (A is for Animals).
- 2) The first number (4) represents the specific symbol.
- 3) The second letter (Y) is a control code used by Kenadar.
- 4) The second number (3) indicates how many text spaces the symbol will require on a text line.

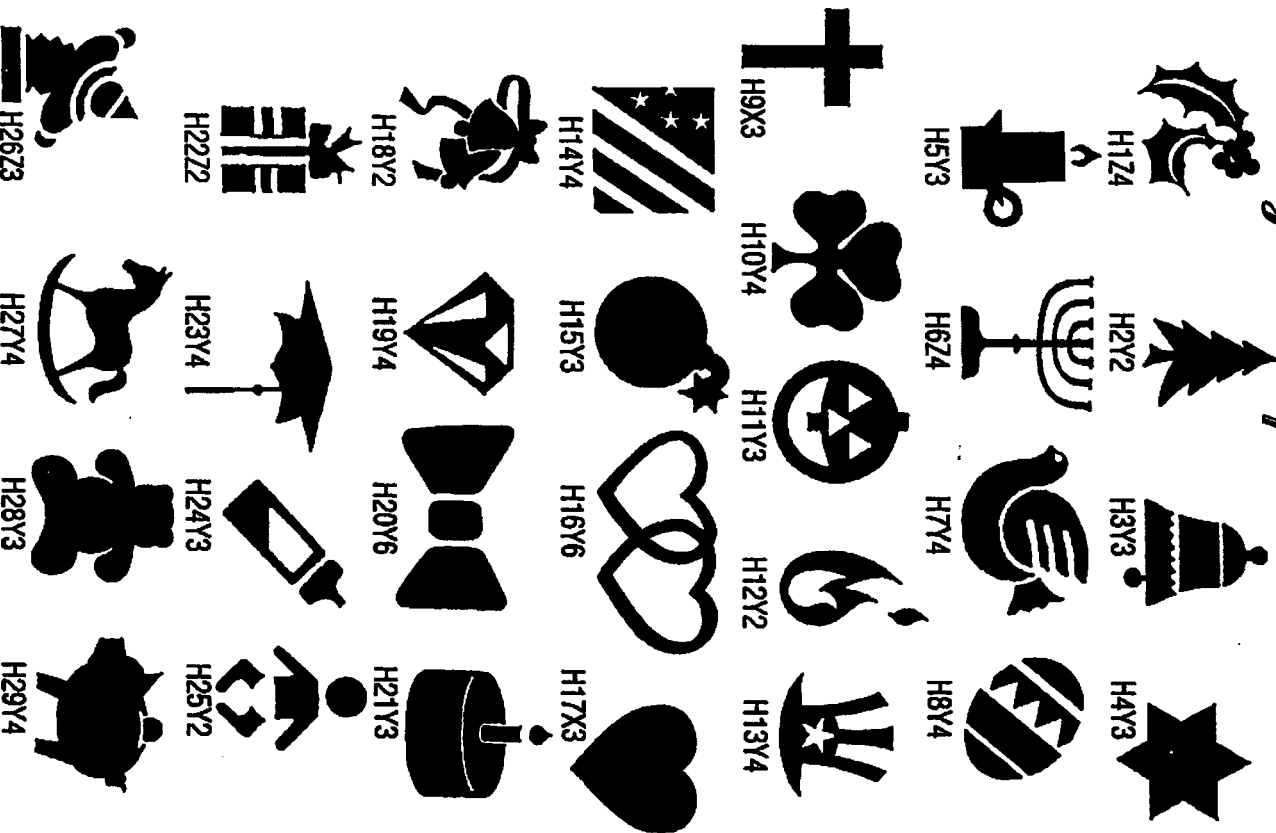
