Subject: Brem-Air Disposal, a division of Waste Management of Washington, Inc. (G-237); Tariff # 20

Enclosed are the revised tariff pages 2, 22 and 25 to the above-referenced tariff. The purpose of these tariff revisions is to reflect the change in the commodity credits for residential and multi-family customers receiving recycling collection services. These tariff revisions reflect a change in the current recycling credit from <\$0.13> per month to a charge of \$0.23 per month for residential customers and a change in the current recycling credit of <\$0.19> per unit to a charge of \$0.05 per unit for multi-family customers.

The change in the commodity credit to a charge is jointly due to the change in commodity values, tonnages and materials composition since the commodity credit adjustment on November 1, 2019. Furthermore, with this filing due to the continuing impacts of "China Sword" we are requesting that the projected revenues be based on the revenues received over the most recent six months as was reflected in last year's filing.

Enclosed for your review are our accounting work papers. In addition, due to the change in the commodity credit resulting in a charge, the commission is requiring that customers be notified of this change in accordance with WAC 480-70-271(4)(c). These notices will be mailed on or before October 1, 2020.
