The annual report changed, plus explanations of the federal requirements on Environmental Justice and serving those with Limited English Proficiency were expanded. The Chapter now includes complaint form and public involvement templates in 15 languages. Our Office will offer two different levels of Title VI training this year. The transmittal email include a link to the basic Level 1 training. We recommend all staff with Title VI responsibilities attend the Level 1 training.
