POLICE INVESTIGATE FATAL VEHICLE VS PEDESTRIAN COLLISION

On December 15, 2021, at approximately 6:13 P.M. Kitsap 911 received multiple 911 calls regarding a motor vehicle versus pedestrian collision in the 1600 block of Bay St in the city of Port Orchard. The vehicle and driver were still on scene.

The first responding officer found an unresponsive adult female in the roadway. The officer provided immediate first aid and chest compressions. Shortly after South Kitsap Fire Rescue arrived on scene the female was pronounced deceased.

Due to the severity of the collision, Washington State Patrol and Kitsap County Sheriff's Office were requested to assist. Police do not suspect speed or impairment were factors in the collision.
