POLICE INVESTIGATE BURGLARIES INVOLVING A STOLEN VEHICLE RAMMING INTO BUSINESSES

On February 8th, 2022, at approximately 11:17 P.M., officers from the Port Orchard Police Department were dispatched to a burglary alarm at the Puerto Vallarta Restaurant located at 1599 SE Lund Ave. When officers arrived, they found the doors to the business were damaged. From the evidence on the scene, it appeared an unknown person had purposely driven into the doors with a dual rear-wheeled truck.


On February 9th, 2022, at approximately 3:30 A.M., officers were dispatched to an alarm at the Extra Mile Convenience store located at 280 Tremont PL W. When officers arrived, they found the front glass door smashed in. Security camera video from the store shows a dual rear-wheeled, Ford CHS Propane truck driving into the door. Two white male suspects entered the store taking tobacco products. The Coffee stand in the parking lot was also burglarized.

The vehicle involved, a 2006 Ford F550, license number B56862Z was reported stolen out of Pierce County.

Suspect one is a white male wearing a white paper mask in a black hoodie.

Suspect two is a white male with red hair wearing a black and gray Bud Light baseball hat with blue and black sunglasses, a red bandana, a brown hoodie, and light brown boots.
