Crime Reporting

- Crime = Punishable by possible incarceration
- Data collected via officer report writing system
- Adjusted/corrected by Administrative Services
- Compiled and reported by Washington Association of Sheriffs and Police Chiefs (WASPC)
- National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS)
- Separated into Group A and Group B

Statewide Crime Profile – Crime down 3.7%

- Crimes against persons 1 4.1 % Every 5.0 minutes
- Crimes against property 📕 1.8 % Every 1.4 minutes
- Crimes against society 49.2 % Every 31.5 minutes

Group A offenses were cleared by arrest or exceptional means 18.9 % of the time.

There were **325** murders statewide in 2021 – an increase of 5.9 %.

There were **1,968** assaults on law enforcement officers and **one** officer killed in the line of duty within Washington State.














KITSAP COUNTY CRIME RATE PER THOUSAND



Community Generated 911 Calls - Jan 2021 - June 2022



Takeaways

- Overall crime up 10.7%
 - Down throughout state 3.7%
 - Related to an increase in persons and property crime.
- On-view arrests up slightly
 - Trespassing and Other Non-Traffic Criminal Violations
- Property crimes (theft, burglary, vehicle theft) remain most common
- Case clearance rate is slightly below average
 - General Investigations Unit (GIU) not fully staffed
