Do not prune Juncus Elk Blue unless absolutely necessary. This grass is evergreen and does not require much maintenance

All shrubs **not** highlighted as trees (purple) or groundcovers (green) can be pruned every year or every other year to keep shape. Only prune in full dormancy between December and February.

Never use a hedge trimmer on trees or shrubs as they are too destructive and do not create clean cuts. Hedge trimmers may only be used on ground covers.

TREES (purple)- Only prune trees as needed. Do no cut more than 2" diam, branch so shape early in the first 4-5 years of establishment. After that, only remove dead or broken branches. Refer to an arborist for any aggressive pruning. No pruning should be needed at this time as sight-line pruning occurred in Winter of 2020.

Groundcovers (green)- can be cut back, hedged, or pruned, nearly every year. Try to cut back after the first hard frost of winter and before spring new growth (Dec-Feb)
