ORDINANCE NO. 864

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING DISCONNECTION OF DOWNSPOUTS
FROM SANITARY SEWERS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RUSTON :

Section 1: It is the policy of the Town of Ruston that downspouts should not connect to the sanitary sewer system, since such connections tend to overload the system and to cause backups and flooding, particularly affecting the properties whose downspouts are so connected.

Section 2: The owners of any premises whose downspouts connect to the sanitary sewer system shall disconnect the same on or prior to the later of the following:

- a) Execution of closing documents on sale of such premises;
- b) July 1st, 2001.

Section 3: Violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable by a fine of \$300.00.


