MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENTS -

<u>Jennifer Jensen</u> – Attended a focus group, along with other Ruston residents, and was invited to discuss opinions on Ruston. Ms. Jensen read an article in the News Tribune related to Point Ruston Development and the fight with the Town of Ruston. Ms. Jensen requested the City better communicate with residents regarding the City's position in a Town Hall meeting.

<u>ORD 1499 – City Budget FY2018 (2nd reading)</u> - In accordance with State law, the Mayor of the City of Ruston completed and placed on file with the City Clerk-Treasurer a proposed budget and estimate of the amount of monies required to meet the public expenses, interest, reserve funds, and expense of government of the city of Ruston for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2018. The Council is required to adopt its budget ordinance prior to January 1, 2018.

<u>Councilmember Kristovich</u> — Was proud of where the City is on the Ruston side of the Point Ruston development and excited for what is to come in the future.
