INFORMATION / BACKGROUND

The property owner on the Southeast corner of 50th Street and Winnifred Street contacted the City recently. That 50th Street is not considered an alley in this location has created a hardship on the property owner. Therefore, this issue was brought to the Planning Commission along with the Winnifred Place street renaming. After discussing the matter, the Planning Commission recommends that the portion of 50th Street which is east of Winnifred Street where it becomes an alley be changed from 50th Street to 50th Place.

The Planning Staff has notified the owners and no objection to the renaming has been made. The effective date for the change is proposed for March 1, 2019 to provide 90 days for the change to be made by the owner, the City and the US Post Office.

FISCAL CONSIDERATION

There is a cost to provide new signage and change city maps for the renamed streets.

BOARD OR COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

Planning Commission recommends re-naming the portion of 50th Street that is East of Winnifred Street “50th Place.”

RESOLUTION NO. 696

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSTON, WASHINGTON, CHANGING THE NAME OF THE PORTION OF “50th STREET” THAT RUNS EAST OF WINNIFRED STREET TO “50TH PLACE” EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2019.

WHEREAS, the property owner on the Southeast corner of 50th Street and Winnifred Street contacted the City due to issues with the portion of 50th street that runs as an alley adjacent to the owner’s property; and

WHEREAS, the fact that 50th Street is not considered an alley in this location has created a hardship on the property owner; and

WHEREAS, this issue was brought to the Planning Commission during its discussion of the Winnifred Place street renaming; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission recommends that the portion of 50th Street which is east of Winnifred Street where it becomes an alley be changed from 50th Street to 50th Place; and

WHEREAS, there are no properties which have an address fronting on this portion of 50th Street and the adjacent property owner supports the change; and

WHEREAS, in order to allow time for the City to order signage, this change should take effect on March 1, 2019; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSTON, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Re-Naming a portion of “50th Street” to “50th Place.” The portion of 50th Street which is located east of Winnifred Street is hereby changed. Starting on March 1, 2019 this street shall be known as “50th Place.”
