ORDINANCE NO. <u>1389</u>

ANORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RUSTON, WASHINGTON AMENDING SECTION 18.05.010 OF THE RUSTON MUNICIPAL CODE TO REMOVE FEES FROM CODE FOR **PLACEMENT** IN A MASTER RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City has established a Master Fee Resolution for consolidating its fees into a single location; and

WHEREAS, the Master Fee Resolution is kept updated from time-to-time; and

WHEREAS, in the 2012 update, the Council desires to continue to move fees in its code into the Master Fee Resolution; and

WHEREAS, RMC 18.05.010 should be updated to remove fees which will then be placed into the Master Fee Resolution; and

WHEREAS, on December 4, 2012, the City Council held the first reading of this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2012, the City Council adopted this Ordinance during its regular meeting at the second reading; NOW, THEREFORE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSTON DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 18.05.010 of the Ruston Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

18.05.010 - Charges.

The <u>fees applicable for the</u> following charges and provisions shall apply to the installation of all new and upgraded electrical service meters shall be established

by resolution of the City Council, including:

- (a) A meter installation fee of \$1,000.00 in a per meter amount as established by Council resolution, exclusive of permit or inspection fees, shall be paid to the Clerk-Treasurer prior to connection of a new service.
- (b)An upgrade meter installation fee of \$250.00 per meter, exclusive of permit or inspection fees, in an amount established by Council resolution shall be paid to the Clerk-Treasurer prior to connection of an upgraded service.
- (c) For structures with multiple meters, the meter installation fee described in subsection (a) above shall apply to the first meter, with an additional meter installation fee of \$250.00 for each additional meter thereafter in an amount established by Council resolution.
- (d) Additional charges will be determined and paid to the Clerk-Treasurer prior to connection to reimburse the <u>TownCity</u> for improvements to its systems required to serve the customer. Such improvements include, but are not limited to, new poles, guy wires or anchors; extension of overhead or underground primary lines, new or upgraded transformers; engineering design work.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Publication.</u> This Ordinance shall be published by an approved summary consisting of the title.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall be effective five days after publication as provided by law.
