"X" indicates the holidays (Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day) when there is no pickup. All pickups will be one day late for the remaining days of that week. Service will remain normal if the holiday falls on a weekend.

INSTRUCTIONS

We offer two separate recycling programs, one for Yard Waste and one for Recycling. Yard Waste is optional and you must subscribe to receive the service.

Yard Waste

Yard Waste customers receive a 65 or 95 gallon container to be placed at the curb on collection day. Do not put plastic bags or other unacceptable items in the yard waste container. Please ensure all items are loose and free fall from the cart to guarantee collection.

Acceptable: Leaves, grass, weeds, shrubs and other compostable organic materials from pruning. Brush, branches, and roots cannot be larger than 4 inches in diameter and must fit into the container with the lid closed.

Not Acceptable: Stumps, demolition wood, rocks, glass, plastics, food waste, flower pots, metal, concrete, sheetrock, asphalt, or other non-organic debris. Also bones, food, manure, or large amounts of dirt will not be accepted. (maximum weight 250 LBS.)

Extra yard waste should be placed next to your container in compostable bags. A small additional fee will be charged for each extra.
