

Chief's Report Ruston Police Department Tuesday, March 16, 2021

Chief of Police:

During the 28 days prior to today, the Police Department logged 89 calls for service. Twenty-four were traffic stops.

- Since the passage of the SOAR municipal code, the Department has been
 working with the City Planner to make sure the new warning signs are in
 compliance with Ruston's standard and with Mr. Johnson to get them installed.
 We are also designing a new city infraction form for submission to the printer,
 and once they are, we will conduct training for the officers regarding the new
 law. Our goal is to commence enforcement within the next 3 weeks.
- Two part-time officers, both previously retired from other agencies, have resigned in the last month. One retired deputy-sheriff from Michigan has been hired, with two others in background.
