

Chief's Report Ruston Police Department Tuesday, August 15, 2023

In a previous 28 days period (July 12-Aug 9), the Department recorded 283 calls for service, 108 of which were traffic stops. A breakdown comparing the percent of change from the same period in 2022 is shown below:
