### **Proposed Council Action:**

This is on for Third Reading. If ready, the Ordinance may be adopted on December 5<sup>th</sup> Otherwise it will return for Fourth Reading and Action on December 19, 2023.

## **INFORMATION / BACKGROUND**

In accordance with State law,<sup>1</sup> the Mayor of the City of Ruston will complete and place on file with the City Clerk-Treasurer a proposed preliminary budget and estimate of the amount of monies required to meet the public expenses, interest, reserve funds, and expense of government of the city of Ruston for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024. The Council is required to adopt its budget ordinance prior to January 1, 2024.<sup>2</sup>

On October 17, 2023 the Council held a preliminary public hearing to hear from the public about their budget priorities. The final public hearing on the budget was held on November 21, 2023. The City's Levy Lid Lift that was on the November General Election Ballot has passed, therefore, the numbers have been changed since the last meeting to reflect these additional revenues. The City is required to pass the budget before the end of this calendar year.

Prior to budget adoption, the City Clerk will have fully complied with state law<sup>3</sup> by publishing notice of the availability of the budget for public review and publishing notice of the required public hearings on the City's proposed tax levy and budget, including a preliminary and final budget hearing.

# **BUDGET OVERVIEW**

The proposed Total Revenues forecasted are \$10,902,721, consisting of Beginning Balances in the amount of \$4,750,031, plus interfund transfers in of \$307,000, and operating revenues of \$5,845,690. The Total Expenditures proposed are \$10,943,654, consisting of operating expenses in the amount of \$5,956,657, plus Interfund transfers out of \$307,000, and Ending Balances of \$4,679,997.

## **ORDINANCE NO. 1575**

AN**ORDINANCE OF** THE **CITY OF** RUSTON, WASHINGTON ADOPTING THE CITY OF RUSTON ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING **DECEMBER 31, 2024, SETTING FORTH THE ESTIMATED** REVENUES AND APPROPRIATIONS, PROVIDING FOR **SEVERABILITY** CORRECTIONS. AND AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with RCW 35A.33.052, the Mayor of the City of Ruston has completed and placed on file with the City Clerk-Treasurer a proposed budget and estimate of the amount of monies required to meet the public expenses, interest, reserve funds, and expense of government of the city of Ruston for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 35A.33.060 and RCW 84.55.120, the City Clerk timely published notice of the availability of the budget for public review and notice of the required public hearing on the City's proposed tax levy and the required public hearing on the City's proposed budget; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing for the City's tax levy was held on October 17, 2023; and WHEREAS, a preliminary public hearing for the City's budget was held on October 17, 2023; and

WHEREAS, a final public hearing was held on the City's budget on November 21, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budget does not exceed the limit of taxation allowed by law to be levied on real property within the City of Ruston for the purposes set forth in the budget, and the estimated expenditures set forth in said budget are necessary to carry on the government and sufficient to meet the various needs of the City of Ruston during 2024; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Total Revenues forecasted are \$10,902,721, consisting of Beginning Balances in the amount of \$4,750,031, plus interfund transfers in of \$307,000, and operating revenues of \$5,845,690. The Total Expenditures proposed are \$10,943,654, consisting of operating expenses in the amount of \$5,956,657, plus Interfund transfers out of \$307,000, and Ending Balances of \$4,679,997; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with RCW 35A.33.075, following the conclusion of the hearing, and prior to the beginning of the fiscal year, the City Council has made any such adjustments and changes as it deems necessary or proper and after determining the allowance in each item, department, classification and fund; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with RCW 35A.33.075, this Ordinance sets forth in summary form the totals of estimated revenues and appropriations for each separate fund and the aggregate totals for all such funds combined; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 17, 2023, the City Council held a public hearing on the tax levy; and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2023, the City Council adopted the tax levy ordinance (Ordinance No. 1573); and

**WHEREAS**, on October 17, 2023 the Council held a preliminary budget public hearing; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 7, 2023, the City Council held first reading of this budget ordinance (Ordinance No. 1575); and

**WHEREAS**, on November 21, 2023, the City Council held second reading and a public hearing on this Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 5, 2023, the City Council held third reading of this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, on December \_\_\_\_, 2022, the City Council adopted this Ordinance during its regular meeting at the \_\_\_\_\_ reading; NOW, THEREFORE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RUSTON DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Annual budget for the City of Ruston, Washington, for the year ending December 31, 2024, is hereby ADOPTED in its final form as shown on the attached Final Budget document, which is attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference.

<u>Section 2</u>. In accordance with RCW 35A.33.075, the totals of estimated revenues and appropriations for each separate fund and the aggregate totals for all such funds combined are set forth below:

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Clerk to Keep Budget on File.</u> Three copies of the Annual Budget adopted herein shall be kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk-Treasurer.

<u>Section 4. Clerk to Transmit Budget.</u> The City Clerk-Treasurer is hereby directed to transmit one certified copy of the Annual Budget which is adopted herein to the State Auditor's Office, and a second copy to the Association of Washington Cities.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Severability</u>. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Corrections</u>. Upon the approval of the city attorney, the city clerk and/or code publisher is authorized to make any necessary technical corrections to this Ordinance, including but not limited to the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, Ordinance numbering, section/subsection numbers, and any reference thereto.

**Section 7. Publication.** This Ordinance shall be published by an approved summary consisting of the title.

**Section 8. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be effective five days after publication as provided by law.
