City of Ruston Capital Facilities Project: Community Center ADA/Safety Improvements



Project Overview:

The Ruston Community Center is the site of the old Ruston School, and is located at 5219 North Shirley Street, in Ruston, WA. The renovation project aims to improve public access and the facilitation of community events by constructing ADA accessibility features such as an elevator, new doors, gender neutral public restrooms, and an ADA access path and ramp with pedestrian lighting and directional signage. Energy efficiency improvements include new windows, LED lighting, and multiple electric heat pump units. Overall functionality will be improved by addressing maintenance issues that include replacement of an aging roof, repairing exterior brick siding, and resurfacing and restriping the north and south parking lots.
