

Dear Rye Brook Resident,

Rye Brook Recreation has been working on its spring and summer programs. Our Little League season will open on April 20th. Registration for Day Camp, Teen Travel Camp, Little League Softball, Recreation Baseball, Rookie League and T-Ball is ongoing. For all other programs, registration will begin on March 20th at 9:30pm. Highlights for this spring/summer season are Rye Brook F.I.T., Cornhole Tournament, Casino Night, Snapology, and Pickleball Impact Zone and Fill Me Up Buttercup.

Online registration allows us to notify you of all available programs. For all recreation Village of Rye Brook run programs you are able to pay online with a credit card.

> A reservation is required for usage of Rye Brook's 9 tennis and pickleball courts. Reservations must be through Court Reserve. In order to make a reservation, you must be in possession of a valid 2024 Season pass. All players on the court must have a reservation during the weekday time slots. On weekends beginning May 11th, tennis attendants will be at both Pine Ridge and Harkness Parks and walk-ons will be permitted when time slots are available as the tennis attendants will be able to track usage and accept fee for the courts. The Court Reserve app on your phones will allow season pass holders the ability to reserve courts up to the hour desired to play when slots are available. Enjoy your tennis and pickleball experience and play safe!

> The Village of Rye Brook will host a number of special events this spring and summer. Rye Brook's 42nd birthday celebration will take place on Saturday June 17th from 12-4pm. It is sure to be a special event. Also, the 3rd Rye Brook F.I.T. event will take place on April 6th. It is a 5K walk to promote fitness and community. We will once again be hosting "Movie Nights In The Park" this summer. We will offer one movie night each month beginning in July through September. The movies and other events are listed under Special Events in our brochure. Every Friday in the month of July, we will be serving Free Ice Cream at Pine Ridge Park for our Ice Cream Friday events.

> Also we will be hosting a Cornhole Tournament on Saturday May 11th. Different age groups will play a double elimination tournament throughout the day. The winning teams will be given a chance to compete against a Village All Star Staff team. There is a maximum of 4 players per team and we will take a maximum of 8 teams per age criteria.

> In addition to the spring/summer events, Rye Brook Recreation would like you to save the dates for these upcoming fall programs: Pumpkin Patch (October 12th) and Winterfest (December 6th)

> Rye Brook Little League will be entering its 22nd season for 2nd through 7th grade players age 12 and under. The Rookie League is entering its 17th season for K and 1st graders. The Rookie League program will be a partnership with Rye Brook Travel Baseball and will mirror their Summer Rookie League program. The inaugural season of T-Ball will mirror the rookie league and run for 3, 4 and 5 year old residents.

> Rye Brook Recreation will be running the "After School For Kids" program at Ridge Street School once again in September. This will be our eighth year running the program and we hope to make this outstanding program even better. This program will run from 3:10-6:30pm at Ridge Street school and is very beneficial for the working families of Rye Brook.

The Harkness Tennis Courts will be resurfaced in the month of August. During this process, the courts will be closed for a two week period.

The Recreation Department is open from 8:30am to 4:30pm on weekdays. We welcome any feedback on our programs. We hope Rye Brook Recreation is meeting the needs of the community. I look forward to seeing you enjoy these fine recreational programs and the beauty of the many parks within the Village.



Tennis Permits

Facilities

The Rye Brook Recreation Department operates nine tennis courts at three facilities. Four are located at Pine Ridge Park (corner of Mohegan Lane and Latonia Road), four at Harkness Park (at Blind Brook High School), and 1 court at Garibaldi Park (on Garibaldi Place, across from the Anthony J. Posillipo Community Center).

Opening Day

Tennis Courts will officially open for the season on <u>April 1, 2024</u>. A valid 2024 tennis permit through Court Reserve is required to reserve a time slot. <u>NOTE</u>: Non-residents are not permitted to play tennis on Village Courts without being accompanied by a resident with a valid permit or a non-resident may purchase a non-resident permit.

Tennis Court Usage

Tennis Courts 1 & 2 at Pine Ridge Park are reserved for Rye Brook approved lessons Tuesday and Wednesday from 9:00am-6:00pm, and all 4 courts on Thursday and Fridays from 12:30-2:30pm.

The Blind Brook High School Tennis Teams use the Harkness and Pine Ridge Courts during April, May and the first week of June, weekdays from 3:00pm – 6:00pm.

Making a reservation: A reservation is required for usage of Rye Brook's 9 tennis courts. Reservations must be done through Court Reserve on a first come first served basis. In order to make a reservation, you must be in possession of a valid 2024 tennis permit through Court Reserve. All players on the court must be in your reservation during the weekday time slots. Non Court Reserve permit holders will be charged a \$5 fee to the permit holder making the reservation. On weekends beginning May 11th, tennis attendants will be at both Pine Ridge and Harkness Parks and walk-ons will be permitted as the tennis attendants will be able to track usage and charge fees. Members will be able to show their reservation at the courts via their ap on their phones. Reservations can be done up to the minute of court time. Court times will be able to see court availability and make your reservation at your desired time. Enjoy your tennis experience and please be safe!

Non permit holders without a permit holder making a reservation will only be permitted when there is a tennis attendant on duty. <u>Tennis attendants will be working on weekends</u> <u>only starting on May 11th.</u> All residents must have a valid tennis permit through Court Reserve by April 1, 2024 or be charged a daily guest fee of \$5.00. Non-residents need to be with a permitted resident and pay a fee of \$5.00. Permits may be purchased throughout the season. Mail or bring in application to Rye Brook Recreation Department, 938 King Street, Rye Brook, NY 10573.

Tennis lessons approved by the Recreation Department have priority on Pine Ridge Park Courts 1 & 2. Schedule to be determined by registration demands. <u>Only lessons through the</u> <u>Recreation Department are permitted on the courts.</u>

While signing up for a family permit, please sign up everyone in your family that will be using the courts. If they are not signed up they will not receive a permit.

Please read the following frequently asked questions to further clarify the Rye Brook tennis procedures.

Which Courts are available for reservation?	The four (4) at Pine Ridge Park and one (1) Court at Garibaldi Park and four (4) at Harkness Park are available for Reservation.	
Who can make a tennis reservation?	Reservations are permitted with a 2024 Season Pass. A Season Pass Holder may bring up to three (3) guests. The pass holder will be charged \$5 per guest to utilize the courts with them and must be present at the time of usage.	
How do I get a season pass?	A season pass can be purchased at CourtReserve.com or App store.	
What happens if someone is on my court at the time of my reservation?	There will be signage at the park stating that reservations are required. When you show up for your reservation, you can prove through your court reserve ap on your phone that the court is yours. If the other party still refuses to leave the court, please contact Rye Brook Police at (914) 937-1020 and they will disburse the other party.	
How do I download the court reserve app?	You can download the court reserve ap on your phone from the app store.	
How many courts may I reserve?	Season pass holders are permitted to possess (1) tennis court reservation at a time.	
How far in advance am I able to reserve a tennis court?	Tennis Courts may be reserved seven (7) days in advance and no later than the hour of play. Reservations must be on the hour. Due to the popularity of the courts, we ask that if you make a reservation, you have confirmation of all players for your reservation.	
What are the times we can reserve a court?	Season Pass holders may reserve 1 hour of court time Monday – Sunday from 8am though 7pm when courts are available. Court times must begin on the hour.	
How can we reserve a tennis court	Tennis courts can be reserved through your Court Reserve app. if you have a season pass. If you do not have the ap downloaded on your phone, you can make a reservation through the recreation department Monday through Friday from 8:30am through 4:30pm excluding holidays.	
How do I know if a court is available when I want to play?	If you go on your court reserve ap, click on book a court and the days schedule will pop up. Go to the court you would like to reserve and click on it. It will ask you whether you would like to book a doubles or singles slot. Follow the prompts to make your reservation.	
Will staff be present at time of reservation?	No attendants will be on site. Season pass holders are expected to have their reservation with them at the time of reservation either on their phone or a paper copy. For reservation conflicts, contact the Rye Brook Police at (914) 937-1020.

PICKLEBALL

We have 4 beautiful **pickleball courts** at Garibaldi Park and Rye Hills Parks. We hope residents enjoy this amenity that is sweeping the nation! For more information on rules for the facility, please see below. Pickleball schedules will be updated periodically at the courts, on CourtReserve online sites. Rye Brook Recreation offers 3 different ways to play Pickleball on the towns' Pickleball Courts:

- #1 "Morning ADULT Open Play" Monthly Community Pass Holders Residents/Non-Residents
- #2 "Pickleball Court Reservations" is for RESIDENTS and NON-RESIDENTS PERMIT HOLDERS
- #3 Pay for Pickleball Lessons; Group/Private Lessons/Events for Residents & Non-Residents

#1 "Organized ADULT Open Play" (via Community Pass)

The Rye Brook Recreation Department offers "Open Play" 5 days/week (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday). Players (Residents and Non-Residents) will need to sign up on Community Pass. The sessions are for either 4-week intervals and the cost is \$20.00 for residents and \$25.00 for non-residents. Nets are supplied by Rye Brook Recreation and Players are expected to help assemble and dismantle nets. This is NOT an instructional program it's for players with current or previous playing experience. Novice/Low Intermediate players will play on Garibaldi Park Tennis/Pickleball Court and Intermediate/Advanced players on Rye Hills Pickleball Courts 1, 2, & 3. In order to play on any certain day players just need to show-up that day. No longer is there a way to sign up by day. Players can no longer see who is signed up on any given day. Players are expected to help put up and tear down the portable nets as a group. Park near the Crawford Park Mansion 122 N. Ridge Street, Rye Brook, NY 10573. Walk 150 ft south toward playground.

HOW TO SIGN UP FOR A PICKLEBALL MONTHLY COMMUNITY PASS: On your computer iPhone.

- 8. This will take you to "verifying your account"

Beginner / Low Intermediate – For individuals who are new to the game and have some racquet skills but still need to learn the basics and scoring.

Intermediate – For individuals who have played pickleball before, understand basic scoring, can carry a game, but not as fast-paced as more Advanced Players.

#2 "Pickleball Court Reservation via CourtReserve***FOR PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY

To be clear the ONLY people who can reserve a Pickleball Court are RESIDENTS & NON-RESIDENTS who are PERMIT HOLDERS for the Village of Rye Brook. Any NON-PERMIT holder can play on the Pickleball Court, as long as a valid permit holder is not looking to play. Please purchase your 2024 permit on Court Reserve in order to reserve court time. To reserve a court: Select the "Reserve a Court on CourtReserve. Rye Brook Recreation is the organization. Click on Create an Account then Select Organization and Pay for Membership.

Types of Permits: Permits are good for all of '2024 and are required to reserve a Pickleball court. See CourtReserve.

PICKLEBALL, continued ...

We ask that all players limit their play to 60 minutes. If a current permit holder arrives on-site during their scheduled permit time, the court must be released by the drop-in user immediately, whether or not play is complete.

What if I don't want to pay for a Permit to reserve a pickleball court?

If you do not want to pay for a permit, you can not reserve a pickleball court.

• 60-Minute Play Rules: On the schedule there are 60-minute play times.

- During designated 60-Minute play times, the "Minute Rule" applies at all times. Players will use the honor system and limit play to 60 minutes.
- · Players must follow Permit Holder to Non-Permit Holder ratios; up to three (3) guests (a mix of resident/

non-residents) to utilize the courts with them and be present on the court at all times.

- All players in the group must leave the court after 60 minutes and allow waiting players to play.
- Players may continue play on a court if there are no waiting players, or if all waiting players have been invited to play and players opted to wait.

• <u>Who can make a pickleball court reservation?</u> Reservations are restricted to Rye Brook Residents and Non-Residents who are Permit Holders ONLY. A permit holder may bring up to three (3) guests (a mix of resident/non-residents) to utilize the courts with them and be present on the court at all times. Residents with permits may not make reservations for non-permit holders to play without them.

<u>Will staff be present to assist with reservations?</u> No attendants will be on site. Permit holders are expected to have a print or digital copy (on their phone) of their 60-minute permit available on-site at all times.

SETUP REQUIREMENTS for CourtReserve (available as a phone app). Select organization "Rye Brook Recreation." For members with a mobile device, the first step is to go to the Reservation screen. The members should:

1-Open the CourtReserve app.

- 2-On the Home screen, tap BOOK A COURT.
- 3-Scroll to the right to locate a Pickleball Court at Rye Hills Park (see pickleball court 1, 2 and 3).
- 4-Select a day, time, and court on the scheduler.

5-Tap RESERVE and Reservation Type, Singles or Doubles.

6-On the next screen, tap the court option. The Reservation screen displays.

7-Creating a reservation

On next screen, members can update and save the reservation settings (CourtReserve auto-fills some fields).

1-The Reservation Type field is auto-filled, but members can tap the field and select a different option.

2-Tap the Duration field and select an option. The End Time field auto-updates. Click SAVE.

3-Tap the Court field and select a different court. (optional)
