Rye Brook Recreation is committed to providing quality recreation programs. In the winter months, our recreation programs are usually moved inside the schools, Bellefair gym and the Anthony J. Posillipo Community Center to get our participants out of the frigid temperatures. The year 2021 has thrown some major Covid-19 curveballs at us and we are forced to rethink the programming that we are offering. We are moving our basketball program indoors again, but we only have access to the Blind Brook High School and Middle School gyms because of the ongoing construction project.

If you do not have access to a computer, our recreation staff will guide you through the process. Your data entry will allow us to get the recreation information to your household in an efficient and timely manner. To register for programs, simply go to the Village's website at www.ryebrook.org, scroll down the home page and you will see a section that will prompt you to register for programs. This link will bring you to Community Pass to register.

Coming this Spring, the recreation department will running the Little League. The Little League Parade will take place on Saturday April 23rd. All Little Leaguers and Rookie Leaguers will march from Ridge Street School to Pine Ridge Park to officially commence the Spring Season. The North East Flag Football (NEFFL) program will be returning to Rye Brook on Sunday mornings on the Rye Brook Athletic Field. The NEFFL is primed to provide young players a fun exciting opportunity to engage in non-contact continuous action while developing skills and learning lessons in teamwork.

We hope that Rye Brook Recreation is meeting your recreational needs. I join my staff in wishing you and your families a healthy and rewarding 2022 New Year and look forward to seeing you at some of our many recreational activities.


### Little League Sponsors Sought for Our 2022 Spring Season
