## What's Happening:

Village residents were present at the June board meeting to express concern about pedestrian safety on Main Street. The Village board is aware of resident concerns and will be working on a plan to address those concerns in the coming weeks and/or months.



Village Office summer hours will change effective July 1, 2024. **Please note:** The office will be closed to the public on Fridays. Water bills and tax bills can be dropped in the drop box with no late charge to residents who wish to use this service.

The Visitor Center is now open for the season and will be open Thursday - Sunday from 11 a.m. until 4 p.m.

# In other news...

The project at the end of Hamilton Street - now officially renamed "Robinson Hill" will begin in the coming weeks. Target completion date is July/Early August.

The Village has awarded a \$4.2MM contract to Marcellus Construction Co, Inc. on May 9, 2024, for drilling and placing a new water intake to replace our 110-year-old intake and add a seawall along the shoreline in front of the intake plant. The work is partially funded by a WIAA grant from NYS of \$2,058,800MM.

Prep work is to begin in late June with mobilization, clearing, grubbing, and staging. The directional drilling for the actual pipe beneath Lake Ontario will commence in early July.

Market Square Park is officially completed.

**Update on the Dog Park:** Work is set to begin next week on the fencing. We look forward to opening soon.

**Just a reminder:** The Town Recycling Center accepts recycling and yard debris **only**. We have been notified that the Town is having some issues with trash being placed into the recycling containers. Please be mindful that this is a free service to village and town residents.
