Resolution 2 of 2021 for the Bond Authorization for the water intake project was passed with an introduction by Mayor Constance and seconded by Deputy Mayor Boulton. Vote 5 ayes (Constance, Boulton, Fay, Mildren and Pacilio), 0 nays.

The purchase of iPads for the Board Members use was authorized in a motion made by Trustee Pacilio and seconded by Trustee Mildren. Vote 5 ayes (Constance, Boulton, Fay, Mildren and Pacilio), 0 nays.

Treasurer Jim Yuhas informed the Board that he and Assistant Treasurer Mary Ann Yuhas will be retiring at the end of Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

Lynn Martin, DPW Superintendent, presented the budget request for the department.

Paul Trudeau, Police OIC, gave an overview of the proposed budget changes for the Police Department.

The working budget was reviewed and explained by the Treasurer, Jim Yuhas.

The Tree Committee request for 2021-2022 funding was reviewed.

The meeting was adjourned in a motion made by Mayor Constance and seconded by Deputy Mayor Boulton at 10:36 am. Vote 5 ayes (Constance, Boulton, Fay, Mildren and Pacilio), 0 nays.
