Section 1. Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1987, as amended, is hereby amended, in part, to read as provided for below.

Section 2. Subsection 9-3 (A)(1) of Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1987 is amended to read as follows:

A. Creation, Appointment, and Organization:

1. The mayor shall appoint seven (7) members, and two (2) alternate members, who shall be Village residents, to the Village Planning Board.

Section 3. Transitional Provisions. The purpose of this Local Law is to provide for the appointment of two (2) alternate members on the Village Planning Board. Consistent with the provisions of Sections 7-706 and 7-718 of the Village Law, this Local Law shall take effect upon publication and filing as required by Section 7-706 of the Village Law and as follows. The two (2) new alternate members shall be appointed under the authority of this Local Law, one (1) alternate member shall be appointed for a term of office, which shall expire on the last day of the Village's official year in calendar year 2011, and one (1) alternate member shall be appointed for a term of office which shall expire on the last day of the Village's official year in calendar year 2014. Upon the expiration of the term of office for each new alternate member of the Village Planning Board, his or her successor shall be appointed for a seven (7) year term.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
