#### **Residential 1**

1. Revised from 96 apartment units to 38 townhome units.

2. Utilizing the same unit prototypes and exterior design as Residential 2.

- 1. Added new color of fiber cement siding and slate stone veneer.
- 2. Added a one-story stone base to the east and north elevations. (See View A)
- 3. Added a one-to-two-story stone base with architectural canopies on top to the northwest corner lobby. Replaced the porcelain tile with warm-colored fiber cement siding above the stone base. (See View B)
- 4. Articulated the north portion of the building with a one- or two-story stone base and vertical breaks above. The building already steps down towards the south side. (See View B and C)
- 5. Replaced a portion of the fiber cement siding with porcelain tile at the southwest corner to recreate a similar look to the southeast corner. (See View C)

- 1. Added a horizontal trim on the top level with a material change at the recess portion of the east elevation. (See View A)
- 2. Replaced the dark gray metal panels with light gray metal panels in some areas. (See View A)
- 3. Incorporated gabled canopies to the building frontage facing the Townsquare. (See View B)

- 1. Revised from 251 units to 309 units.
- 2. The building height changed from 5-story to 6-story.
- 3. Add a pool roof deck on top of the parking.
- 4. Ground floor shops and retail space are consistent with the previous layout. (See View A and B)
- 5. Modified the storefront awnings and light fixtures to enhance pedestrian experience at the corner of the building with the white brick facing the Townsquare. (See View A)
- 6. Exterior design followed the previous design language, with some 1-story and 2-story bases added to reduce the scale of the building. (See View C and D)

- 1. Added trellises to the private decks above the two-story base facing the Townsquare. (See View A)
- 2. Replaced the porcelain tile with warm-colored stone veneer on the south and east elevations and slate stone veneer on the retail frontage to the north. (See View A, B, and D)
- 3. Added a variety of plaster colors. Above the podium, the building has two different color configurations of plasters for the west and the east portions. (See View B, C, and D)
- 4. Articulated the building with a horizontal trim on the top one or two levels in various locations. (See View B, C, and D)
- 5. Created a pattern on the garage elevations by placing the garage screens behind the structural frames and the crash walls. (See View C and D)
