#### Project Scope





- Reconfigure the intersection at Fourth St and Second St





Maintain existing access to driveways on the north side of Fourth St



### #2: Second St (Westbound) Left-Turn Closure


Conduct traffic analysis to evaluate the closure of the Second St (westbound) left-turn pocket



- 1st Street & Greenfield Ave: Green backed sharrows




