Message from City Manager

Dear San Rafael Community Members,

Have you visited Pickleweed Park recently? I encourage you to experience for yourself why this beautiful park located in the San Rafael Canal neighborhood attracts thousands of community members throughout the year. The park has always been a special place, serving as a gathering place where friends, families, and neighbors come together. With



the adjacent community center, this crucial community hub hosts numerous events, sports leagues, childcare programs, library services, and recreational programs that strengthen community bonds and create a sense of belonging for our residents.

Much of the park infrastructure dates back over 30 years. While there have been some updates, the park is showing signs of aging, which presents opportunities for improvement to better serve the community. That's why I'm thrilled to announce that this fall marks the beginning of the Pickleweed Park Enhancement Project! This \$8.59M project, funded by a \$4.24 million grant from the National Park Service Land and Water Conservation Fund and substantial matching City investment, will bring significant upgrades. These include a new year-round, all-weather turf sports field, an outdoor basketball court, updated play and exercise equipment, improved park restroom facilities, a gazebo, pathway enhancements, landscaping improvements, and an additional 18 parking spaces. This project has been a community priority for over a decade and will notably enhance access to the City's only municipal soccer field.

These improvements will ensure that Pickleweed Park and the Albert J. Boro Community Center will continue to offer opportunities for everyone in our community to discover, learn, and play together. Construction will start in September 2024. During this time, portions of the park, including the soccer fields, will be closed temporarily until construction is complete. We'll do our best to limit disruptions during construction, and of course, we're looking forward to celebrating the reopening of the park once the work is complete in Spring 2025!


The Downtown Library will be temporarily relocating!

This elegant three-story house is a blend of Queen Anne and Eastlake styles, built in 1888 on 11 acres. In keeping with the style of the period, it has a complex and intriguing roof line of gables and chimneys, variously shaped bays, and plenty of decorative details.

The interior is beautifully rendered in rich redwood panelling, and features ornate mantelpieces, hardwood floors, and elegant wall coverings. The foyer is especially striking with its huge decorative fireplace and floor-to-ceiling stained-glass windows.

The property was most notably owned by the Dollar family from 1906 until the early 1970s. The estate was named Falkirk in honor of Captain Robert Dollar's Scottish birthplace and to celebrate his civic involvement and generous donations to the City of San Rafael.

Falkirk Cultural Center is operated by the City of San Rafael and serves as a historic site, contemporary art gallery, and a popular event venue.
