FIRE DEPARTMENT STANDARD CONDITIONS FOR TCO & CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY

TCO

- 1. Final of the UG fire line permit.
- 2. Final of the fire sprinkler system permit.
- 3. Assurance that the fire department standpipe systems are fully operational.
- 4. Final of the fire alarm permit.
- 5. Final of hood/range kitchen fire protection permit.
- 6. Testing to ensure that a fire evacuation alarm and notification to an approved 24-hour alarm company occurs when:
 - a. The fire sprinkler system is activated.
 - b. The fire alarm system is activated by:
 - i. Smoke and heat detection units.
 - ii. Pull stations.
 - iii. Kitchen hood range fire protection systems.
 - c. All Emergency exit release devices activate.
- 7. Testing of the main sprinkler valves to ensure that the tamper switches notify the fire alarm company with the appropriate trouble signal.
- 8. Approval from County of Marin Radio for the DAS/ERCCS system.
- 9. Testing of any internal wired emergency communications systems.
- 10. Keys and emergency contact information are placed into the Knox key box.
- 11. Fire extinguishers mounted as per approved plans.
- 12. Fire Department override controls for elevators operational.

For Fire Sign Off of B-Permit and Granting of Certificate of Occupancy

- 1. 24-hour emergency vendor contact information is posted on the fire alarm panel and fire sprinkler riser.
- 2. Red zones/fire lanes noted on the plans painted, stenciled and posted.
- 3. All fire alarm and fire sprinkler signage mounted as per approved plans.
- 4. Completed Emergency Plan.
- 5. Binder of all required testing of emergency equipment.*
- 6. All evacuation signage posted.
- 7. Established Emergency Director.

*The following documents will be required to be maintained in a binder that is available for inspection:

- Fire Safety Director Certificate (Valid for 5 years)
- Facility Emergency Plan (Update plan as needed)
- Annual Life Safety Training log
- Annual Fire Drill log
- Annual Fire Alarm Test Certificate, includes the testing of (but not limited to): Pull Stations, Visual Warning Devices, Audibility of Fire Alarm System, Waterflow and Tamper Devices, Smoke Detectors, Firefighters' Phone System, Stairwell Emergency Phones, and Heat Sensors.
- Sprinkler/Standpipe (5-yr Certification and Annual inspection)
- Emergency Generator- (Weekly and Monthly)
- Elevator Emergency Equipment and Key Operation (Quarterly)
- Exit and Emergency Lighting (Quarterly)
- Emergency Exit and Release Devices (Annually)
- Smoke Control Systems and Fire/Smoke Dampers (Quarterly)
