San Rafael City Council and Mayor:

I am an owner of my property on Marquard Avenue for the past 49 years and I am in complete opposition to the City wanting to close the Marquard Avenue /Second Street Intersection.

That intersection provides needed access for the complete Hillside community of Families, Individuals and Seniors who need this access for Emergency Vehicles to respond when emergencies arrive and they always do.

If the intersection is closed the Emergency response time will be greatly affected and the speed bump installed at the closure will create more problems and Liability for the City of San Rafael because of the unsafe situation that will take place with this terrible project.
