## **Questions & Answers**

- 1. Regarding requirement 2 regarding the 25 foot intervals, does this data exist or are you looking for fresh surveying of the shoreline?

  The existing data was presented as exhibit with this RFP. There is no other data available.
- 2. Does the City have a defined schedule duration and /or milestones for this study they can share with us?
  No, please propose a schedule and milestones you anticipate to fulfill the scope of work.
- 3. Are there any requirements for the minimum number of project references required for this RFP? Please provide at least two (2) project references.
- 4. Does the city have underground vector data for storm drainage facilities such as storm drain pipe networks and outfall structures? If so, can this be shared before the proposal is due?

  No, the City does not have the requested vector data.
- 5. Are there any other georeferenced data being collected now? Does the city plan on collecting other data in the near future?

No additional data is currently being collected or planned to be collected in near future.

- 6. What other modeling related to sea level rise, riverine flooding or interior drainage has been conducted in the City?

  None, except for the record elevations collected shown on the exhibit included in the RFP.
- 7. Our Risk management and Legal committee reviewed the contract presented by the city. As per the Senate Bill SB-496 in effect since January 1, 2018 we are requesting changes to the language of the indemnification terms in the contract. The edits are presented in the attached document. Would the city be open to the change in language of the Agreement?

  Please include your contract exceptions in the proposal upon submittal. If your firm is chosen, contract changes may be negotiated.
