## Water-conserving Plumbing Fixtures Single Family Residential Properties

Per California Civil Code Sections 1101.1 – 1101.8, effective January 1, 2014, when a building permit is issued for alterations or improvements to single family residential buildings, <u>ALL</u> non-compliant plumbing fixtures in the home shall be replaced with water conserving plumbing fixtures as a condition of final inspection approval. (See our published guidelines for exceptions)

## Non-compliant plumbing fixtures are defined as follows:

- 1. Any toilet manufactured to use more than 1.6 gallons per flush.
- 2. Any interior faucet that emits more than 2.2 gallons of water per minute.
- 3. Any showerhead manufactured to have a flow capacity of more than 2.5 gallons per minute.
- 4. Any urinal manufactured to use more than 1 gallon of water per flush.
