NOTICE OF PREPARATION FOR ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT (EIR)

You are invited to comment on the scope of EIR for the following proposed project:

PROJECT: 815 B Street (formerly 809 B St, 1212/1214 Second St), (Second and B St: New San Rafael Housing) The City of San Rafael will be the lead agency and will prepare an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for a proposed new mixed-use housing project at the northwest corner of 2nd and B Streets in San Rafael. The project proposes a 4-story structure, containing 41 residential units, 2,095 sq. ft. retail and 49 parking spaces within a ground floor garage. This Notice of Preparation is sent pursuant to Section 15082 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines to announce the initiation of the EIR process and to solicit comments from responsible and trustee agencies, utility providers, organizations, neighboring property owners, and interested parties concerning the scope of issues to be addressed in the EIR. COMMENT PERIOD/PUBLIC HEARING: The City invites written comments on the scope of the EIR and alternatives that should be considered. Due to the time limits mandated by state law, your response must be sent at the earliest possible date, but no later than 30 days from the date of this notice, or **Tuesday, July 23, 2013 by 5:00 p.m.**. Written comments should be sent to City of San Rafael, Community Development Department, 1400 Fifth Ave/P.O. Box 151560, San Rafael, California 95915-1560, Attn:. Lisa Newman, Contract Planner. Comments may also be sent by email to <u>lisapnewman@gmail.com</u> with the heading "Second and B Street: New San Rafael Housing" in the subject line. Comments should focus on identifying specific environmental impacts to be evaluated during the EIR process and suggesting project modifications or alternatives that would be less environmentally damaging while achieving similar project objectives. Scoping comments should focus on issues and alternatives to be studied, not on expressing a preference for a particular alternative.

The City will also hold a public scoping meeting before the City of San Rafael Planning Commission to accept oral comments on the scope of the EIR on **Tuesday**, **July 23**, **2013**, **at 7:00 p.m**. in the San Rafael City Council Chambers, 1400 Fifth Avenue, San Rafael, CA.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN: The purpose of the Notice of Preparation and comment period is to announce the initiation of the EIR process and process and to solicit comments from responsible and trustee agencies, utility providers, organizations, neighboring property owners, and interested parties concerning the scope of issues to be addressed in the EIR. The EIR is to assess the potential environmental impacts of all phases of the proposed project including planning approvals, construction, and operation. Following conclusion of this scoping period, a Draft EIR will be prepared that studies the environmental issues of the topic areas included in this scoping. Public hearings will then be scheduled to accept public comment on the Draft EIR, when completed, and the project merits, as well as prior to certification of a Final EIR for the project. It is anticipated that this process will take several months to complete. A decision on the merits of the project will be made after the Final EIR is considered and certified.
