Water-conserving Plumbing Fixtures **Single Family Residential Properties**

Per California Civil Code Sections 1101.1 – 1101.8, effective January 1, 2014, when a building permit is issued for alterations or improvements to single family residential buildings, ALL non-compliant plumbing fixtures in the home shall be replaced with water conserving plumbing fixtures as a condition of final inspection approval. (See our published guidelines for exceptions)

Non-compliant plumbing fixtures are defined as follows:

1. Any toilet manufactured to use more than 1.6 gallons per flush.
2. Any interior faucet that emits more than 2.2 gallons of water per minute.
3. Any showerhead manufactured to have a flow capacity of more than 2.5 gallons per minute.
4. Any urinal manufactured to use more than 1 gallon of water per flush.
