**NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC:** In accordance with Government Code Section 54972, on or before December 31 of each year, an appointments list of all regular and ongoing boards, commissions and committees which are appointed by the legislative body of the local agency must be prepared. The City of San Rafael Boards and Commission Appointments List shows all current members, the term expiration date, and the current membership requirements.

### **ADA Access Advisory Committee**

**Qualifications:** The five (5) voting ADA Committee members and any alternate shall consist of the following, each having the same duties and responsibilities:

- Persons who are, or family members of, City of San Rafael residents with disabilities; and/or
- Individuals residing in the City of San Rafael serving persons with disabilities in Marin County; and/or
- Property owners, business owners, or individuals residing in the city of San Rafael with expertise and/or affiliations with private or public organizations concerned with issues of accessibility and/or other issues of concern to persons with disabilities; and/or
- One member of the Committee may represent the San Rafael business community interest.

**Purpose:** The ADA Access Advisory Committee provides valuable input in determining disability policy for the City of San Rafael. The ADA Access Advisory Committee provides input, advises the City on matters relating to people with disabilities, and is a primary public networking resource between persons with disabilities, disability service agencies, representatives from government agencies, and others. Members of the committee represent a broad cross-section of members of the community with disabilities, reflecting multiple disabilities, and the cultural and gender diversity of the wider disability community. The ADA Access Advisory Committee works in conjunction with the City of San Rafael.

**Purpose:** The goal of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) is to promote bicycling and walking as viable means of transportation throughout San Rafael; to provide conceptual input on public bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure projects; and to support the implementation of the City's Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan. park, recreation, child care and cultural services.

Requirements for eligibility: 1) District Representatives: Each district representative must reside in the district they represent. 2) At-Large Members: Must reside in city limits.

**Purpose:** The purpose of the Commission to make decisions or advise the Council on land use and property development issues. The Commission assures that new development is consistent with our long-range General Plan, State laws and other public policies that advance the interests of our community.

### **Design Review Board**

**Qualifications:** Must be a resident of the City of San Rafael. At least two (2) members shall be licensed architects or licensed building designers; at least one member shall be a licensed landscape architect; at least one of the five (5) members shall have background or experience in urban design; and the alternate member may have qualifications in any of the above fields of expertise.

**Purpose:** The Board shall serve as an advisory body to the city for the purpose of reviewing and formulating recommendations on all major physical improvements requiring environmental and design review permits, except that an alternate streamlined review process may be allowed for

certain eligible projects by ordinance or resolution of the city council. The Board may also serve as an advisory body on other design matters, including minor physical improvements or administrative design permits, referred to the board by the community development director, planning commission or city council. The Board shall provide professional design analysis, evaluation and judgment as to the completeness, competence and appropriateness of development proposals for the use and setting and to recommend approval, approval with conditions, redesign or denial based on design standards adopted by the city council.

**San Rafael Representatives on Marin County Boards**

**Marin County Commission on Aging**

**Qualifications:** According to the Older Americans Act, membership shall be composed of:

- (a) a majority of persons 60 years or older;
- (b) service providers;
- (c) members who reflect the geographic, racial, economic, and social complexion of the area they represent; and
- (d) at least one member who represents the interests of the disabled.

**Purpose:**

The Marin County Commission on Aging is a 23-member federally mandated advisory council to the Marin County Board of Supervisors. The Commission works closely with the Aging and Adult Services on behalf of Marin's older adults. Commissioners are appointed to three-year terms by either the Board of Supervisors or the 11 incorporated Cities and Towns in Marin. In addition, Marin County's Senior Assembly Member and Senior Senator, representatives of the California Senior Legislature (CSL), also serve as ex-officio members for a four-year term.
