


CURRENT RECOMMENDATION

- 3. Adds signalized intersection at East Street





























2nd Street questions:

- 5. Are there any other suggestions to improve this design?









- Francisco Boulevard West MUP




- Significant investment into downtown traffic signal infrastructure, with detection, controllers, and communication upgrades

- Construction complete January 2021







- Construction through April 2021






