# Caltrans Continues Work on the Harbor Bay Bridge Project Starting Tonight at 9PM

Marin County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform the Harbor Bay Bridge Replacement Project in the City of San Rafael starting tomorrow night at 9PM. The project team will begin bridge removal work on the original structure, located at the northbound off-ramp on US Highway 101. The bridge removal process requires the closure of 3 lanes starting at 9PM, followed by a full ramp closure from 11PM – 6AM.

There will be a series of lane and full ramp closures throughout the project along with a significant amount of temporary lane shifts. More details are outlined below. Meanwhile, motorists are advised to drive with caution and follow all posted directional signs. Traffic advisories and detour routing options will be utilized to keep the public and all motorists updated, safe, and thoroughly informed throughout the life of the project. Standard operational construction hours are Monday – Friday starting at 7AM – 4PM. However, late night and weekend work will be required during the bridge removal process. The public will be notified in advance. Meanwhile, initial lane and bridge closures will take place in the following stages:

### **Scheduled Closures for Tonight**

- 3 lane closure from 9PM -11PM
- Full ramp closure 11PM 6AM

#### **Traffic Control Measures**

Standard traffic control measures will include: Traffic Cones, Barricades, Crash Cushion Trucks, and portable changeable message signs (PCMS's). California Highway Patrol (CHP) will also be on location, patrolling the scene and enforcing traffic ordinances


#### **Detour Plans**

#### DETOUR PLAN: Northbound (NB) US Highway 101 Off-Ramp Closure at Central

- Continuing along Northbound US Highway 101-
- Take the NB Loop (off-ramp) to N. San Pedro RD.
- Turn Right onto N. San Pedro Rd.
- Make another Right onto Merrydale Rd.

- Connect with Southbound (SB) US Highway 101 until Wesson Ave off-ramp exit.
- Continue on Hetherton St.
- Turn Left onto 2nd St.



#### > DETOUR PLAN: Northbound (NB) US Highway 101 Off-Ramp Closure at Central San Rafael.

- Via Francisco Blvd. exit, make a Right onto Bellam Blvd
- Make a Left turn onto Francisco Blvd;
- Then, a Right turn on Grand Ave.
