I oppose the provision of Measure A that funnels sales tax revenue to a non-profit organization, in this case, MALT, the Marin Agricultural Land Trust. I believe this is an inappropriate use of sales tax revenue and that non-profit organizations are capable and responsible for their own fund raising.

If we choose, as a community, to provide various non-profits with funding from the City's collection of sales tax revenue, why wouldn't we also support the Red Cross or the San Francisco/Marin Food Bank? It is simply not appropriate for the City to act as a fund raising arm for ANY non-profit organization by providing a guaranteed revenue stream!

I encourage you to withdraw support of any proposed renewal of Measure A that includes MALT as a beneficiary. MALT has been accused of conflicts-of-interest with sitting board members who financially benefited from overvalued easements and Measure A funds. According to an article in the Marin IJ, from September 7, 2020, MALT returned over \$800,000 in Measure A funds to the County.
