My name is Breanna Kennedy. I oppose renewing DST's contract For the follwoing reasons:

- DST incentivizes vagrancy in downtown San Rafael. Hiring vagrants to sweep the streets that they themselves litter on/make filthy- literally gives vagrants a reason to stay/sleep in downtown San Rafael.
- In 2019 five Bay Area cities announced that they would look into allegations of sexual harassment and toxic work place culture at Downtown Streets Team. San Rafael was one of them as reported by San Jose Inside. In December of 2020, the Palo Alto city council refused to pass a 3 year extension to the DST contract because DST had not provided a redacted copy of the report on the outside investigation it had commissioned. San Rafael should also demand transparency from DST before renewing their contract."
