NIGHTTIME CONSTRUCTION ON US-101 - CENTRAL SAN RAFAEL (HARBOR BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION)

Sunday Night, August 29

MARIN – Caltrans District 4 (Bay Area), will continue construction work on Stage 2, Phase 2 of the Northbound (NB) US-101 Central San Rafael off-ramp bridge (Harbor Bridge Replacement Project) in Marin County. Starting Sunday night, August 29, from midnight until 6:00 AM, for approximately the next two weeks. The work involves demolishing the existing bridge and may cause loud noises for residents within range of this project. Caltrans will make every effort to minimize the noise during this bridge demolition.

There will be no lane closures during this phase of work.
