Hello, thank you for the letter to neighbors of the Sun Valley Park. I live on the 200 block of Solano St. I am not in favor of destroying the gazebo. I don't know what the issues have been but destroying the gazebo seems extreme. It's a lovely structure and adds to the park. It's great for parties and I believe it generates revenue when people reserve it. Surely we could find an enhancing solution such as motion sensor lighting or Police rounds or better visibility. Destructive stop gap solutions don't always get at the root causes and fail to serve the broader neighborhood. Destroying a lovely park fixture might only serve direct neighbors who bought property right next to a public park presumably knowing there was some risk associated.
