I am commenting on the general state of San Rafael's sidewalks and bike paths; I have made dozens of reports of people blocking the sidewalk/bike path entrance by parking on the sidewalk on Lincoln Ave at the bike path on ramp next to 101, and the city has yet to do anything. Additionally, people constantly dump garbage here, and no one yields at the cross walk. It's like living in the Bayview in San Francisco. People parking on the sidewalk is one of the lowest trashiest uses of public space. I could barely get by here, and often there are families with strollers behind the corner. There is no safe accessible off ramp for bikes and pedestrians, not to mention someone crashed into the CalTrans fence onto the bike path in the fall and that has yet to be repaired. I am so sick of this.
