Those of us in the canal district are aware that there have been many power outages in the past that were purported to be from the effect that storms have on above ground utility lines.

I am imagining that the underground utility resolution is in consideration of both the aesthetic quality of having no above ground wires/poles as well as that underground utilities are less likely to be damaged due to storms.

It is important to me that we take into consideration how electrical utilities/lines affect human health since they do produce electro magnetic frequencies and our hearts and brains are greatly affected by electromagnetic fields.

If these utilities are placed underground, how far underground will they go, and who is in charge of measuring electromagnetic fields the emit from either poles and lines, or underground facilities?

Will the public know where the lines/utilities are placed in terms of exact locations?
