San Rafael, Marinwood, and Cal State Parks have a project underway, that's designed to clear invasive and non-native species.

On June 18th, the MWPA (Marin Wildfire Prevention Authority) board of directors will meet to approve projects that have been recommended by the advisory technical committee.

Chief White was not able to attend the last MWPA Ops meeting on May 2nd but was told all the projects were approved.
