- Sewer Maintenance Superintendent
- Sewer Lead Maintenance Worker
- Sweeper Operator

\*Must obtain Class B license within one year of date of hire and become subject to DOT when license is obtained.

An employee may be given a written exemption from this Policy by the Human Resources Director, if, although the employee's classification is listed above, the employee's job duties do not include performing the "safety sensitive function" of driving one of the following vehicles.
