
## When an Employee Either Has or Reports Symptoms of COVID-19



- 1. Close Contact is defined as any household member, individuals that have shared a home within 14 days of a person's COVID-19 diagnosis intimate partners, caregivers, or someone who was within 6 feet of an infected person for 15 minutes or longer
- 2. An employee who has had a test for a medium/high risk exposure should not return to work until they provide results to HR
- 3. If employee does not have remote work agreement and must quarantine, HR and Department Director will work on developing a temporary remote work assignment (i.e. DSW work assignment)
- 4. Provide Marin Health and Human Services "At-Home Quarantine and Isolation Safety" document
