**BUS INFORMATION** When riding on our chartered buses, you are not allowed to walk around while the bus is in motion. Please remember that water may not be available on the bus, so bring a small bottle of water if you require some while on a trip. Please, no talking to the bus driver while he/she is driving, as it is unsafe. Please wear your name badge while on trips and at events. No drinking of alcohol or smoking allowed on the bus. Bus restrooms are for emergencies only! **NO PARKING IN COMMUNITY CENTER LOT FOR TRIPS.** 

**PAYMENTS & REFUNDS** Cash and checks are gladly accepted. **CURRENTLY, WE ARE UNABLE TO ACCEPT CREDIT CARDS.** 100% refund if you cancel before deadline date; NO REFUND if you cancel after deadline. 
