NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **General Municipal Election** is to be held in the City of Santa Ana on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following measures(s):

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the City Council, or any members thereof authorized by the City Council, or any individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations, may file a written argument, not to exceed 300 words in length, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, in favor of or against the City measure. The required signature form is available in the City Clerk's Office.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, based upon the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and Voter Information Guide for the election, the City Clerk has fixed **Friday**, **July 26**, **2024**, **at 5:00 P.M**. as the date after which no arguments in favor of or against the City measures may be submitted to the City Clerk for printing and distribution to the voters as provided in Elections Code Article 4. Arguments shall be submitted to the City Clerk at City Hall, 20 Civic Center Plaza, 8th Floor, Santa Ana, California accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization and the printed name and signature of at least one its principal officers who is the author of the argument. Arguments may be changed or withdrawn by their proponents until and including the date fixed by the City Clerk.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the City Council has determined that rebuttal arguments, not to exceed 250 words in length, as submitted by the author(s) of the opposing direct arguments, may be filed with the City Clerk, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting if, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, not more than 10 days after the final date for filing direct arguments. When the City Clerk has selected the arguments in favor of and against each measure, a copy of the argument against the measure will be sent to the author(s) of the argument in favor of the measure and the argument in favor of the measure will be sent to the author(s) of the argument against the measure. Rebuttal arguments must be filed with the City Clerk, City Hall, 20 Civic Center Plaza, 8th Floor, Santa Ana, California no later than 5:00 P.M. on Monday, August 5, 2024.

NOTICE IS FUTHER GIVEN that if more than one argument in favor of or against any measure is submitted, the City Clerk shall select one of the arguments in favor of and one of the arguments against each measure, as set forth in Elections Code Section 9287.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that any ordinance, impartial analysis, or direct arguments filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination in the City Clerk's office for not less than 10 calendar days from the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analyses. Any rebuttal arguments filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination in the City Clerk's office not less than 10 calendar days from the deadline for filing rebuttal arguments.
