



City of Santa Ana Neighborhood Cleanup Program Container Guidelines

Material allowed in the containers are limited to:

- BBQ's, bicycles, or exercise equipment
- Carpet rolls (6x2) or padding
- Furniture (couches, desks, etc.)
- Hardware
- Lumber and fencing
- Mattresses or box springs
- Non-donatable clothes, bedding, books, or toys
- Toilets or countertops
- Unwanted household items

Material NOT allowed in the containers:

- A/C Units or furnaces
- Appliances (Refrigerators, microwaves, etc.)
- Auto parts or tires
- Construction and Demolition Debris (Dirt, drywall, concrete, etc.)
- Electronic Waste (Computers, televisions, phones, etc.)
- Glass or mirrors
- Hazardous Waste (See below)
- Machinery (Copy machines, sawmills)
- Oil, paint or chemicals of any kind
- Oversized items (Tool sheds, swing sets, camper shells, pianos, spas in one piece)
- Tree trunks

DO NOT DISPOSE OF THE FOLLOWING HAZARDOUS MATERIALS IN ANY TRASH CONTAINER:

- Automotive products (antifreeze, motor oil, fluids)
- Batteries (home and automotive)
- Computers
- Fluorescent light tubes and ballasts
- Fuels
- Herbicides
- Household cleaners
- Medicines
- Mercury (thermometers and thermostats)
- Paint
- Paint products (latex and oil)
- Pesticides
- Polishes and waxes
- Pool and spa chemicals
- Propane tanks
- Televisions
- Wood preservative
