

City of Santa Ana Neighborhood Cleanup Program Overview & Procedures

Join forces with your neighbors to enhance your neighborhood's cleanliness! The City of Santa Ana's Neighborhood Cleanup Program provides residents an opportunity to properly dispose of bulky items that do not fit in their residential trash cart or bin. It also welcomes neighborhoods to organize a community cleanup to improve the appearance of their neighborhood.

Each fiscal year (July 1 – June 30), the City of Santa Ana in partnership with Republic Services, offer up to five (5) large 40-yard roll-off containers, free of charge, to neighborhoods, Homeowner Associations (HOAs), and mobile home parks for Saturday hosted events. Containers are delivered to specified addresses within the city by Saturday morning at 8:00 a.m., and collected that same day between 12:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. Container placement is reviewed and approved by City staff prior to confirmation of event. It is recommended that cleanup events run from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Who qualifies for this program?

Any neighborhood associations, Homeowner Associations (HOAs), or mobile home parks located within the city limits qualify for this program. Cleanups must be organized by authorized neighborhood representatives or HOA/mobile home park leaders. Homeowners shall not use this program for private use (i.e., home remodeling/improvements).

What are the groups responsibilities?

The authorized representative requesting the cleanup will act as the organizer. The organizer is responsible for recruiting volunteers (at least one per container) to monitor containers during the cleanup for the duration of the event to prevent hazardous disposals and overflowing containers. They may also distribute flyers advertising the event to residents in the neighborhood. City staff will provide up to 50 flyers per container at no cost.

How do I schedule a cleanup?

To schedule a Neighborhood Cleanup, complete our online form with your details. Please submit your request at least three (3) weeks before your earliest desired cleanup date. A maximum of seven (7) containers are scheduled per Saturday and requests are scheduled on a first-come, first-served basis. City staff will reach out to you to confirm the date, quantity, and location of the container, as well as provide free flyers. They will verify that the organizers understand the expectations of the program during the cleanup and provide container guidelines for use during the event. Staff will place appropriate "No Parking" signage 48 hours prior to the event and coordinate container delivery and removal with Republic Services.
