

## LICENSE TYPES AND PRIVILEGES

Listed below are the various types of retail licenses issued by the Department of Alcohol Beverage Control and each license privilege.

- Type 20    Off-sale beer and wine
- Authorized the sale of beer and wine for consumption off the premises where sold.
- Type 21    Off-sale general
- Authorizes the sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits for consumption off the premises where sold.
- Type 40    On-sale beer (Type 60, on-sale beer seasonal)
- Authorizes the sale of beer for consumption on the premises where sold and the sale of beer for consumption off the premises where sold.
- Type 61    On-sale beer public premises
- Authorizes the sale of beer for consumption on the premises wherein no person under 21 years of age is allowed (see Section 25663.5 for exception) plus the sale of beer for consumption off the premises where sold.
- Type 41    On-sale beer and wine eating place
- Authorizes the sale of beer and wine for consumption on a bona fide public eating place type premises plus the sale of beer and wine for consumption off the premises where sold.
- Type 42    On-sale beer and wine public premises
- Authorizes the sale of beer and wine for consumption on the premises wherein no person under 21 years of age is allowed (see Section 25663.5 for exception) plus the sale of beer and wine for consumption off the premises where sold.
- Type 47    On-sale general eating place (Type 49, on-sale general seasonal)
- Authorizes the sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits for consumption on a bona fide public eating place type premises plus the sale of beer and wine only for consumption off the premises where sold.
- Type 48    On-sale general public premises
- Authorizes the sale of beer, wine, and distilled spirits for consumption on the premises wherein no person under 21 years of age is allowed (see Section 25663.5 for exception) plus the sale of beer and wine only for consumption off the premises where sold.
