Warner Avenue Improvement (Main to Oak) Project

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- The project location is 0.3 miles along Warner Avenue between Main Street and Oak Street.
- The improvement consists of widening the roadway from four to six lanes, with three lanes in each direction.
- Other improvements include storm water drainage and the undergrounding of utilities to enhance community beautification.
- Safety and accessibility features include narrow travel lanes, raised median, landscape parkways, wider sidewalks, ADA compliant curb ramps, and protected bike lanes.

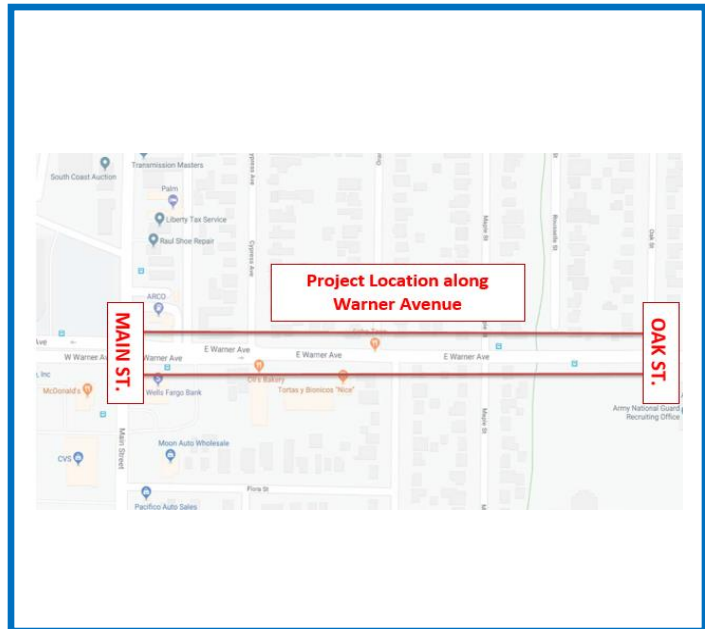
